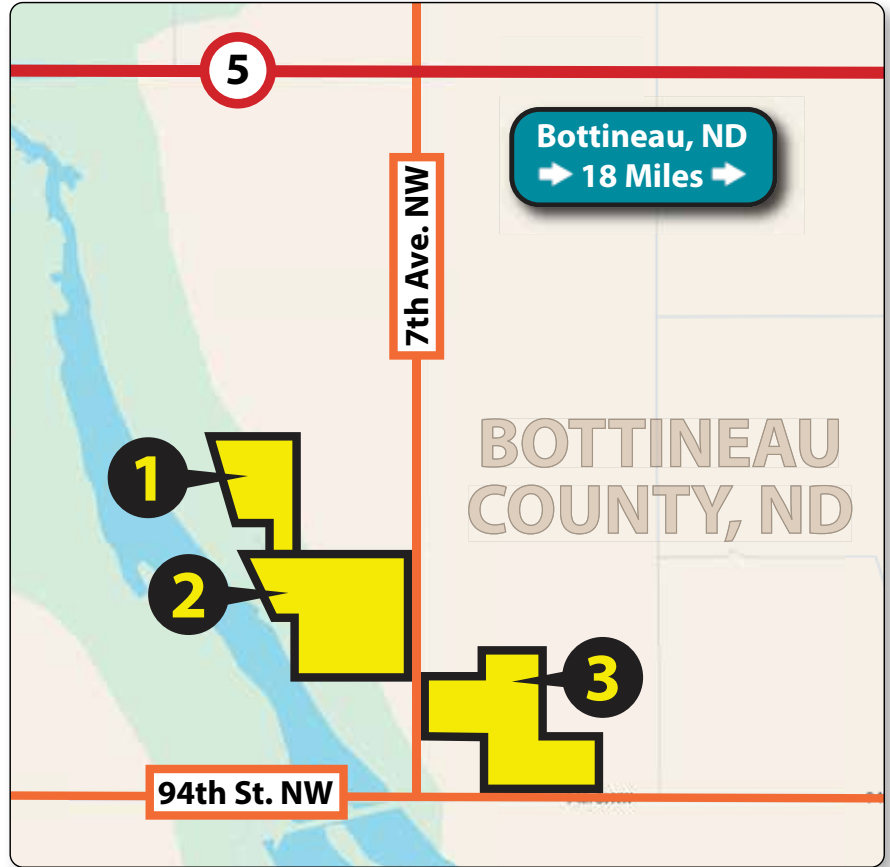
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INTRODUCTION

This farmland, featuring 153.7 +/- acres of cropland and 216.5 +/- acres of Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), is in western Bottineau County, ND. Approximately 74 acres of CRP land will expire in 2026 and can be converted to cropland. This CRP has a Soil Productivity Index (SPI) of 72! The cropland has mostly Hamlet-Balaton Loam soil with an SPI of 82.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Bottineau, ND: proceed 18 miles west on ND State Hwy #5, then 2 miles south on 7th Ave. NW for Parcels 1 & 2. For parcel 3, proceed a ½ mile further south.



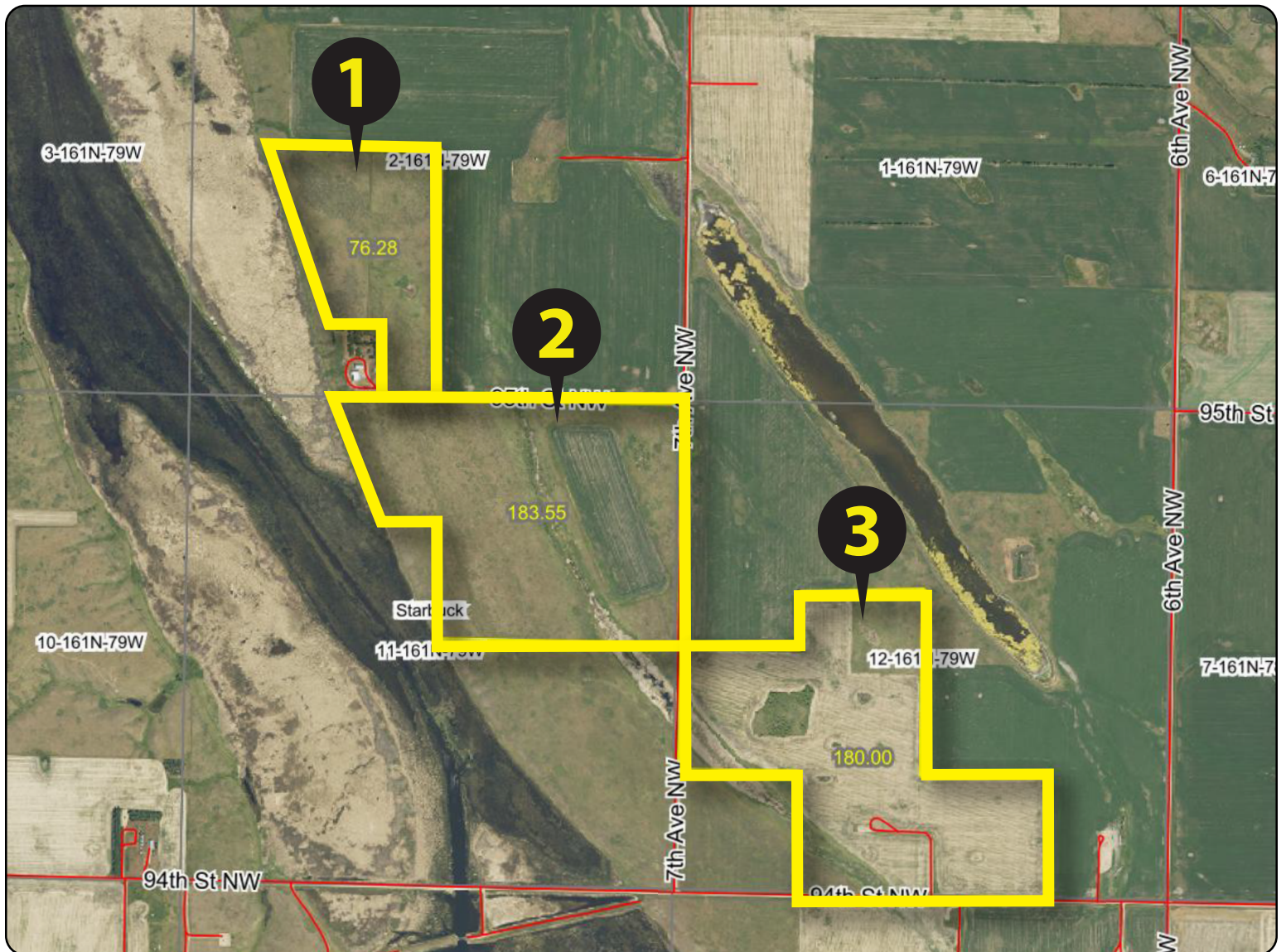
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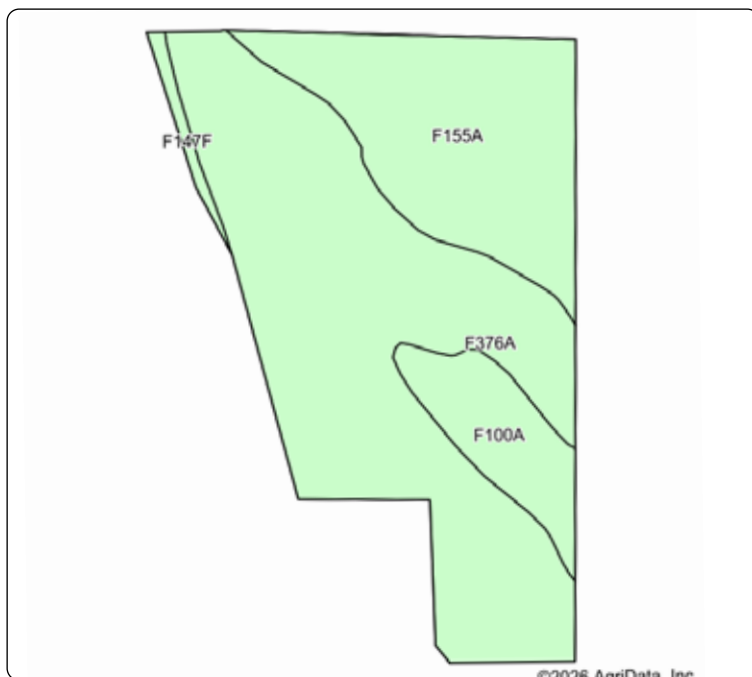

TERMS & CONDITIONS

I. Terms and Conditions of Auction

All bidding is open to the public without regard to a prospective bidder's sex, race, color, religion, or national origin.

A. If you intend to bid on this property, you will be required to provide a cashier's check or personal check in the amount of 10 percent of the purchase price as earnest money on the date of the auction. If you are the successful bidder you will be required to complete and sign a standard Real Estate Purchase Agreement.

B. If you are the highest bidder on any of this property, you will be required to deposit a check with the closing agent who will hold the money in escrow until the closing date. All documentation will be available for your review prior to commencement of the auction. All real estate sales must be closed and the total balance of the purchase price paid on or before 12/11/26. After the auction sale you will be given an appointment date and time with the Closing Agent for a closing date to close the transaction.

II. Bidding Procedures

All bidding is open to the public. You need only to raise your hand and shout out your bid, or instruct any of the ring men to do so on your behalf. Anyone who wishes to bid must first register to obtain a bidder's card at the registration desk.

Retain your bidder number for the duration of the auction. You are responsible for your assigned number. The property is sold when the Auctioneer announces, "sold," identifies the winning bid number and the amount of the bid and the information is recorded by the Auctioneer or his designee. In case of a tie bid, bidding will be reopened between the two tied bidders. The high bid cannot be withdrawn once the Auctioneer determines it to be the winning sale bid.

III. Purchase Agreement, Marketability, Signing Area

At the time the auction is complete, the successful high bidder must sign a standard Real Estate Purchase Agreement to purchase this property for which it was the high bidder. An appointment date to close the transaction will be furnished to the Purchaser after the Purchase Agreement is signed. The transaction must be closed and the money paid on or before December 11, 2026, or the Purchaser will be in default and the earnest money paid herein will be forfeited to the Seller.
