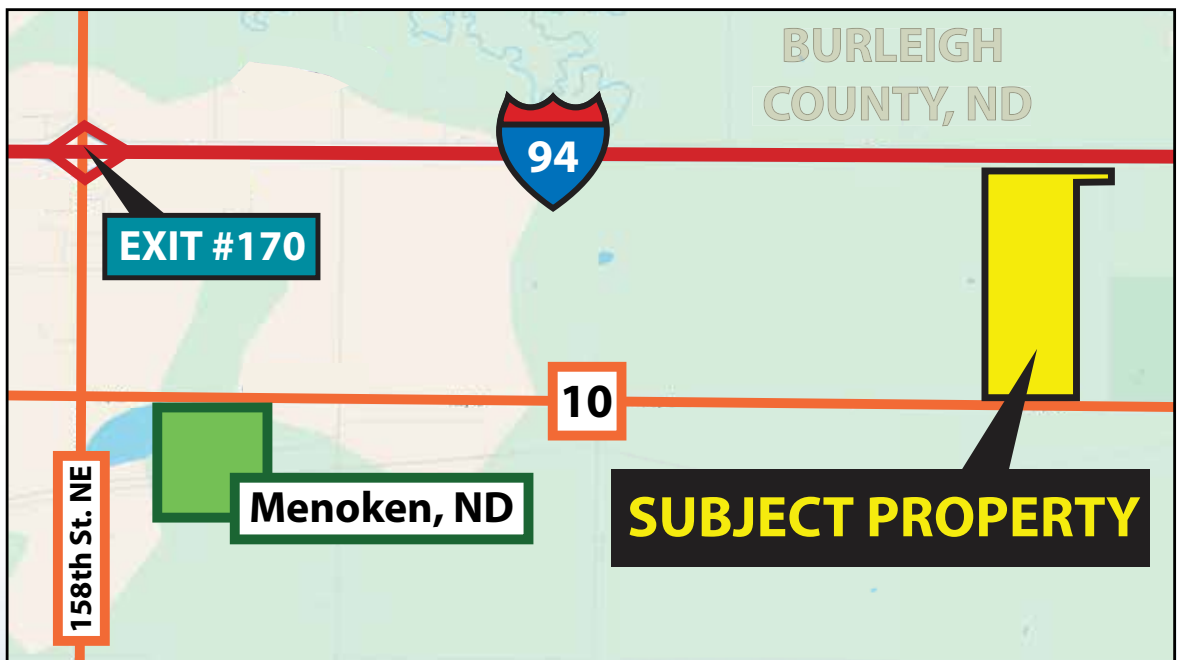

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INTRODUCTION

Auction Note: This highly productive parcel of farmland offers development potential with great visibility from I-94 and frontage with access along Highway 10. The cropland features over 80 +/- acres of Rosglen Silt Loam soils, known for strong crop production, with Soil Productivity Indexes (SPI) as high as 95, and an overall SPI of 75.6. Mature tree rows help protect the soil from erosion and provide a natural windbreak and cover for wildlife. The cropland is currently seeded to alfalfa and will be available for the 2026 crop year. Buyer may have immediate possession!

- No U.S. Fish & Wildlife easements.
- Property is subject to an oil pipeline easement and an electrical powerline easement.
- Highway 10 access: Approach located on the southwest corner of the property.
- North access: Take 210th St. NW (county-maintained road) north to the edge of the property.
- A 100-foot access easement runs along the north side, allowing access from the northeast.
- Seller will reserve all subsurface mineral rights.

From Menoken, ND, take ND Hwy. #10 east for 2.5 miles. Property will be on the north side of the road.



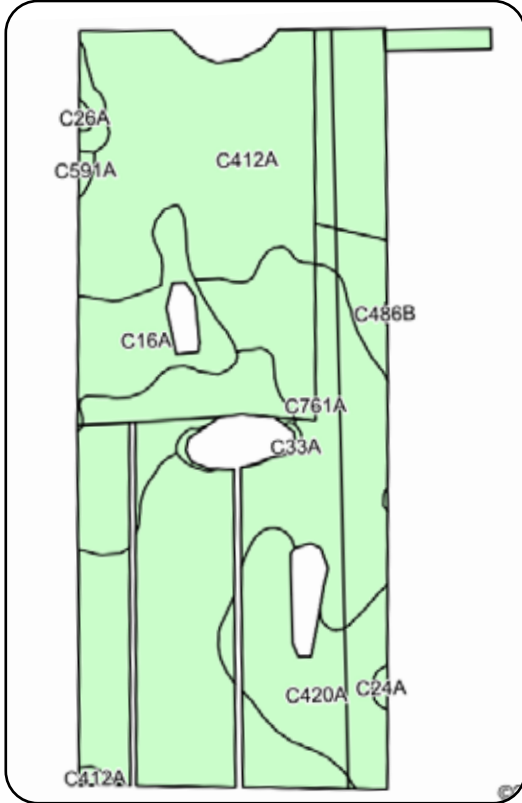

TERMS & CONDITIONS

I. Terms and Conditions of Auction

All bidding is open to the public without regard to a prospective bidder's sex, race, color, religion, or national origin.

In case of a tie bid, bidding will be reopened between the two tied bidders. The high bid cannot be withdrawn once the Auctioneer determines it to be the winning sale bid.

III. Purchase Agreement, Marketability, Signing Area
